# CHAPTER -1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission"), a statutory body under the first proviso to section 82(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), has been authorized in terms of section 86 and section 62(1) of the Act to determine the tariff for a) supply of electricity by a generating company to a distribution licensee, b) transmission of electricity, c) wheeling of electricity and d) retail sale of electricity, as the case may be, within the State of West Bengal.
- 1.2 The West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as WBSEDCL), is deemed to be a licensee under the Electricity Act, 2003 in terms of fifth proviso to Section 14 of the Act wholly owned by the State Government and is engaged in the business of distribution of electricity within the area of supply of WBSEDCL in the State of West Bengal and the distribution tariff of WBSEDCL shall be determined by the Commission.
- 1.3 In terms of West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Tariff) Regulations, 2011, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as the 'Tariff Regulations'), the Commission vide order dated 28.05.2019 in case no SM-19/19-20 decided that, the seventh control period shall be of three years consisting of 2020 21, 2021 22 and 2022 23. The Commission extended the last date of filing tariff petition for 7<sup>th</sup> control period upto 31.08.2020 considering repeated prayer of the utilities of the State in view of issuance of Third Amendment of Tariff Regulations and continuing lockdown conditions as per direction of the Government to contain spread of COVID-19 pandemic.
- 1.4 WBSEDCL submitted the tariff application for three years of seventh control period under the Multi Year Tariff (MYT) framework on 28.08.2020 and the same was admitted by the Commission in case no. TP-89/20-21. WBSEDCL was accordingly, directed to publish of its tariff application in the newspapers. The gist was published on 02.11.2020 simultaneously in newspapers namely (i) 'The Telegraph' (English), (ii) Millennium Post (English), (iii) 'Anandabazar Patrika' (Bengali) and (iv) 'Bartaman' (Bengali). The gist along with the tariff application was also posted on the website of WBSEDCL. The publication invited the attention of all interested parties, stake holders and the members of the public to the application for determination of tariff of





WBSEDCL for the seventh control period and requested for submission of suggestions, objections and comments, if any, on the tariff application to the Commission latest by 23.11.2020. Opportunities were also offered to all to inspect the tariff application and to take copies thereof.

- Objections to / comments on the aforementioned tariff petition of WBSEDCL for the seventh control period were received by the Commission from (i) All Bengal Electricity Consumers' Association (ABECA) and (ii) APS consultants within the stipulated time period.
- 1.6 The Commission, thereafter, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and Tariff Regulations, passed the tariff order dated 28.03.2022 in respect of WBSEDCL in case no. TP- 89/20-21 determining the Aggregate Revenue Requirement (in short 'ARR') of WBSEDCL for each year of the seventh control period, along with the tariffs of WBSEDCL for the years 2020 21 and 2021 22. The objections and suggestions on the tariff petition of WBSEDCL for the seventh control period along with the analysis and findings of the Commission has been recorded in the tariff order dated 28.03.2022. WBSEDCL on receipt of the aforesaid tariff order of 2020 21 and 2021 22 submitted its gist for approval and the same was approved by the Commission and the approved gist was of the tariff order for 2020 21 and 2021 22 was published in newspapers and on the website of WBSEDCL on 12.04.2022.
- 1.7 The Commission now proceeds to determine the revenue recoverable through tariff by WBSEDCL during the year 2022 – 23 as also the tariff of WBSEDCL for 2022 – 23 on the basis of ARR determined for 2022 – 23 in the tariff order dated 28.03.2022 in case no TP-89/20-21 after necessary adjustments in accordance with the Tariff Regulations as detailed in the subsequent chapter.





# CHAPTER -2 SUMMARISED STATEMENT OF AGGREGATE REVENUE REQUIREMENT & REVENUE RECOVERABLE THROUGH TARIFF FOR THE YEAR 2022 – 2023

- 2.1 As stated in the preceding chapter, the Commission determined the ARR of WBSEDCL separately for each of the three years of the seventh control period consisting the years 2020 21, 2021 22 and 2022 23 in the tariff order dated 28.03.2022 in case no TP-89/20-21 (hereinafter referred as 'the 7<sup>th</sup> MYT order') based on the analysis and findings recorded in that order. The Commission in the MYT order has determined the ARR amounting to **Rs. 2126849.92 lakh** for the year 2022-23. Summarized statement of ARR for 2022 23 was given in Annexure-7C to the 7<sup>th</sup> MYT order dated 28.03.2022.
- 2.2 Revenue from sale of power to other licensees:

WBSEDCL in its 7<sup>th</sup> MYT petition proposed to sale power to other licensees in the State viz. CESC, Railways (as deemed licensee) and Sikkim, in addition to sale of power to its own consumers. WBSEDCL in its petition proposed Rs. 71212.80 lakh as revenue recovered from sale to CESC, Railways and Sikkim during the year 2022 - 23. The Commission in paragraph 5.8.3 of the 7<sup>th</sup> MYT order has already clarified that, the rate / price of power purchase or sale between two licensees are to be decided under the Power Purchase Agreement following the relevant provisions under the Electricity Act 2003 and not under Tariff determination process in terms of section 62 of the Act. However, to arrive at the revenue to be recovered from own consumers of WBSEDCL, the Commission considers to adjust the proposed amount of Rs. 71212.80 lakh as income of WBSEDCL from sale of power to CESC, Railways and Sikkim are adjusted from the net ARR of WBSEDCL.

- 2.3 Adjustment of Regulatory Assets and other payables:
- 2.3.1 The Commission in the 7<sup>th</sup> MYT order considered adjustment of a total amount of Rs. 402171.73 lakhs of regulatory assets created in APR orders for different years upto 2017-18 with the ARRs of 2020 -21 & 2021-22 and decided to adjust the balance amount of Rs. 6183.22 lakhs pertaining to APR order of 2017-18 with the ARR of 2022 23 or subsequent order. The Commission now decides to adjust the balance recoverable amount of Rs. 6183.22 lakh with the ARR of 2022-23.





- 2.3.2 The Commission in the FPPCA & APR order of WBSEDCL for the year 2018-19 in Case No. FPPCA 102 / 21-22 and APR 89 /21-22 dated 27.07.2022 has admitted Rs. 125618.48 lakh recoverable from the years 2022 -23 and onwards as may be decided by the Commission. Now, the Commission decides to adjust the entire amount of Rs. 125618.48 lakh with the ARR of 2022 -23.
- 2.3.3 The Commission in the FPPCA & APR order of WBSEDCL for the year 2019-20 in Case No. FPPCA 103 /21-22 and APR 90 /21-22 dated 27.07.2022 has admitted Rs. 190135.34 lakh recoverable from the years 2022 -23 and onwards as may be decided by the Commission. The Commission decides to adjust Rs. 179376.00 lakh with the ARR of 2022 -23. Adjustment of balance Regulatory Asset of Rs. 10759.34 lakh pertaining to APR and FPPCA order of 2019-20 will be adjusted to the tariff orders of subsequent years.
- 2.4 Considering the above adjustments, the total revenue recoverable from the consumers and the average tariff during the year 2022-23 are determined as below:

2.5 In view of directives given by the Department of Power, Government of West Bengal under section 108 of the Electricity Act, 2003 vide notification no 332-PO/O/C-IV/IE-60/13(Part-VA) dated 31.12.2018, the tariff for consumers in erstwhile DPL area is maintained same as per the tariff and MVCA applicable to DPL consumers on 31.12.2018. Accordingly, the average tariff of WBSEDCL area consisting of consumers of erstwhile DPL and the remaining consumers of WBSEDL are separately determined below:

#### CHAPTER – 3 TARIFF ORDER FOR 2022 – 23

- 3.1 In the previous chapter, the Commission, in accordance with the Tariff Regulations, has determined for WBSEDCL, the revenue recoverable through tariff and average tariff of consumers for the years 2022 23. The Commission now proceeds to determine the tariff schedule applicable to the consumers of WBSEDCL and also the associated conditions of tariff of WBSEDCL for 2022 23.
- 3.2 WBSEDCL has submitted that the tariff structure for the consumers of DPL area is different from the tariff structure of WBSEDCL and therefore it is continuing tariff of DPL for its consumers as per the order of the Commission from 01.01.2019. Accordingly, WBSEDCL has proposed tariff of different consumer categories of erstwhile DPL area separately for the ensuing years of seventh control period.
- 3.3 Government of West Bengal, vide its Notification No. 328/PO/O/C-IV/1E-60/13 (Pt -VA) dated 26.12.2018 notified that with effect from 01.01.2019, entire distribution business and activities undertaken by DPL along with all associated assets and liabilities will be transferred to WBSEDCL. Government of West Bengal subsequently vide Notification No. 332 PO/O/C-IV1E-60/13 (part-VA) dated 31.12.2018 in exercise of its power under section 108 of the Electricity Act directed this Commission for approving the transfer of asset and approve & allow WBSEDCL to continue charging existing tariff and present Monthly Variable Cost Adjustment (MVCA) of DPL as on 31.12.2018 from the consumers in the DPL's licensed area as an interim measure until further order.
- 3.4 Tariff schedule and conditions of Tariff for consumers of erstwhile DPL during 2022 23:
- 3.4.1 Considering the direction of Government of West Bengal mentioned under paragraph 3.3 above, the Commission decides to maintain the tariff schedule for erstwhile DPL consumers during the years 2022 23 similar to that as on 31.12.2018. Accordingly, Tariff schedule for erstwhile DPL consumers for the year 2022 23 is given in Annexure 3A1 for LV and MV consumers and at Annexure 3A2 for HV and EHV consumers. All other conditions related to tariff as prevailed on 31.12.2018 shall continue till further order.
- 3.4.2 The tariff for 2022 23 shall be for the period from 01.04.2022 and will continue till further order. WBSEDCL shall continue to levy the MVCA of DPL as on 31.12.2018.





- 3.4.3 The MVCA realized during the period from 01.04.2022 and to be realised as per this order by WBSEDCL is subject to truing up during Fuel and Power Purchase Cost Adjustment (FPPCA) and Annual Performance Review (APR) for the year as per provision of Tariff Regulation.
- 3.5 Tariff schedule and conditions of Tariff for consumers of WBSEDCL (excluding erstwhile DPL consumers) during 2022 23:
- 3.5.1 From the analysis made in previous chapter the average tariff for balance consumers in WBSEDCL area for 2022 23 remains same as that of the existing rate of tariff during 2019 20 after adjustment of regulatory assets and revenue from consumers of erstwhile DPL. In view of this, the Commission proposes no change in the tariff schedule and other terms and conditions of tariff for the year 2022 23 from that of 2019 20. Accordingly, the Tariff schedule for 2022 23 is given in Annexure 3B1 and 3B2 for LV & MV consumers and at Annexure 3B3 for HV & EHV consumers.
- 3.5.2 All the rates and conditions of tariff mentioned in the paragraph 3.5.1 above are effective from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 and will continue till further order of the Commission except the green tariff and promotional EV charging tariff specified in paragraphs 3.5.6 and 3.5.7, which will be effective from the next billing cycle from issuance of this order.
- 3.5.3 There will be no separate MVCA from 01.04.2022 to date of issue of this order. Any variation between the revenue realised by WBSEDCL (including MVCA) upto the month of issue of the order vis-à-vis the amount realizable as per the tariff schedule is subject to truing up during FPPCA and APR for the year as per provision of Tariff Regulation. However, WBSEDCL shall compute the MVCA as per Tariff Regulations afterwards and shall realize /refund accordingly.
- 3.5.4 Rebate for demand side management shall continue at the prevailing rate and conditions for those categories of consumers to whom these were applicable during the period. From the date of issuance of this order licensee has to ensure that, the rebate is applicable to the consumers who make their payments within due date.

#### 3.5.5 Green Tariff:

3.5.5.1 Clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 86 of the Electricity Act 2003 inter-alia specifies that, while discharging its function, the State Commission shall promote procurement of renewable energy. The Ministry of Power, Government of India has





also issued various directions for promotion of renewable energy in India. The Government of India has a vision to achieve 43% of its energy requirement through renewables by 2030. A vibrant market segment termed as GTAM has also been introduced for trading in renewable energy. Further, the Ministry of Power, GoI, has also notified Green Open Access Rules as a major reform to promote renewable energy through Green Open Access by enabling the commercial and industrial consumers to 'Go Green'.

- 3.5.5.2 The Commission has also noted the initiative taken by the Government of West Bengal and WBSEDCL for implementing the PM KUSUM scheme for agricultural consumers and also for promotion of roof top solar in the domestic and agricultural segments. The Commission has also noted that many State Electricity Regulatory Commissions have introduced a 'Green Tariff' in the range of 50 paise per unit to 70 paise per unit for promotion of renewable energy.
- 3.5.5.3 Keeping all these factors in mind and the fact that there is growing consciousness among the consumers to opt for 100 percent green energy to contribute in their own ways towards achieving zero carbon economy, the Commission decides to introduce a 'Green Tariff' of 50 paise per unit for all consumers other than domestic and agriculture consumers. The 'Green Tariff' is to be levied over and above the retail tariffs who intend to consume 100 percent green power for an uninterrupted period for at least six months. The additional 'Green Tariff' ensures that there will be no adverse tariff impact on the remaining consumers.
- 3.5.5.4 WBSEDCL shall specifically indicate the 'Green Tariff', if any, in their electricity bills along with amount of 'Green Tariff' payable by the consumers for the relevant period. The Commission may, from time to time, review the green tariff. The details of category wise green tariff collected including the total energy therein shall be furnished in the APR application by WBSEDCL.

#### 3.5.6 Promotional tariff for Electric Vehicle charging stations:

3.5.6.1 In addition to promoting the renewables, the Government has also decided for promotion Electric Vehicles to achieve overall reduction of carbon footprint. The Commission in line with such Government Policy has already allowed single part tariff at average cost of supply i.e., at Rs. 6.98 per unit for EV Charging Stations in the Tariff Order of 2019 - 20. However, no significant increase in Electric Vehicle





Sector in the State has yet been noticed during these years. Further it is noted that, there are surplus power with the licensee during 'other than peak period' and with increasing solar integration availability during day hours will also increase. Thus, to balance the need of EV promotion as well as better management of surplus availability the Commission decides to allow following promotional time-of-day single part tariff for EV Charging Stations:

- (a) Rs. 6.00 per unit during the peak hours (17:00 hrs to 23:00 hrs)
- (b) Rs. 5.50 per unit during the other than peak hours

The rates will be effective from the next billing month of the date of issuance of the order. Prior to giving effect of the above rate, the EV charging station tariff as per tariff schedule will continue.

- 3.5.6.2 Any EV Charging Station has the liberty to go for complete green resource by applying for 100% green energy with payment of 'Green Tariff' as specified in paragraph 3.5.6 above.
- 3.5.7 Any matter, which has not been explicitly mentioned in this order, shall be guided by regulations 2.9.8 and 2.9.9 of the Tariff Regulations.
  - 3.6 It is open to the State Government to grant any subsidy to any consumer or any class of consumers in the tariff determined by the Commission for WBSEDCL. If at all any such subsidy under the provisions of the Act is intimated to WBSEDCL and to the Commission by the Government of West Bengal with clear indication of the consumer or class of consumers to be subsidized and the amount of the subsidy proposed to be given is paid in advance, the tariff of such consumer and / or the class of consumers shall be deemed to have been reduced accordingly as has been indicated by the State Government. However, such direction of the State Government shall not be operative till the payment is made by the State Government in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Regulations made thereunder, and the tariff as fixed by the Commission shall remain applicable. In accordance with the Tariff Regulations, the State Government is required to communicate the decision to WBSEDCL and the Commission within 15 days from the date of receipt of the tariff order, whether it shall give any subsidy to any group of consumers etc.
  - 3.7 WBSEDCL shall clearly indicate in the consumer's bill (a) the amount payable in terms of the tariff determined by the Commission (b) amount payable for green tariff, if any (c)





the amount of the State Government subsidy, if any and (d) the net amount payable as per provisions of the Tariff Regulations.

- 3.8 The Commission observes that, WBSEDCL is operating its pumped storage project (PPSP) to mitigate its load generation balance, primarily for peak support. It is observed that, with increased renewable integration in the power system the role of storage is becoming very crucial. With the new government policies for increased renewable purchase obligations, green open access, providing standby /banking supports to renewable open access consumers, ancillary service mechanism, etc. opportunities of storage services are widening. In view of above, the Commission directs WBSEDCL to explore all the avenues for efficient and economic utilization of its pump storage plant and submit a report before the Commission within three months.
- 3.9 The Commission notes that, in terms of regulation 6.1.1 of the Tariff Regulations, the recovery of capacity charges for its hydro generating stations and PPSP, except plant size of 25 MW and below shall be based on plant availability factor. WBSEDCL shall comply with the requirements of regulation 6.4.2 and submit information regarding availability and actual generation to SLDC in line with regulation 6.4.2 of the Tariff Regulations, in such format as may be required by SLDC.
- 3.10 WBSEDCL shall present to the Commission a gist of this order in accordance with regulation 2.9.6 of the Tariff Regulation within three working days from the date of receipt of this order for approval of the Commission, and on receipt of the approval, shall publish the approved gist in terms of the aforesaid regulation within four working days from the date of receipt of the approval of the Commission.
